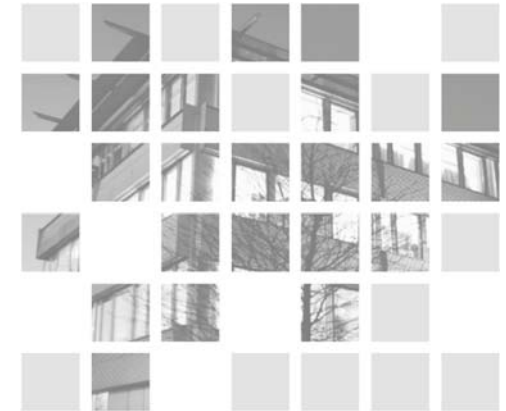

The transition from the Construction Products Directive (CPD) to the Construction Products Regulation (CPR) requires the revision of long existing technical regulation, both at European and Member State level. For many construction products this means more than just a formal adoption of new templates. It requires a new perspective on the principles of the Single Market of the European Union. Otherwise standard writers and regulators might face troubles as the number of non-published standards and court cases demonstrate.

To overcome the situation, a constructive dialogue and close cooperation between the European Commission, CEN, EOTA and construction product manufacturers is required. The European Commission established a system of assessment by HAS consultants. But we believe, dialogue between stakeholders is essential prior to that. European harmonized technical specification must not intervene national regulation. On the other hand, Member States must take care that all requirements are addressed sufficiently.

The workshop will start with the bird's perspective and explain in general the different routes to place construction products on the market. After that it will provide latest information regarding the new European Assessment Documents (EADs) superseding the world of ETAGs. Much more in detail, the current draft of the future European harmonized standard for External Thermal Insulation Composite Systems (ETICS) will be presented by the Convenor in charge. The agenda will be rounded-up by an outlook on how differently national requirements may be established today and in the future.

The aim of this workshop is to create a common understanding, to explain the draft standard and the remaining challenges, to foster the dialogue between regulators and industry, and to prepare industry for the future harmonized technical specifications being relevant for ETICS.
